Akal Academy is the first IB authorised world school to run Primary Years Programme outside National Capital

Region (DELHI NCR). Currently about 400 children are studying in IB World School.

International Baccalaureate (PYP)

Nursery to grade V

Admission Procedure

- Admissions are allowed in Nursery to grade V.
- For the Nursery grade, admission is granted to children with age 3 years and above as on 1st March.
- No written test or formal interview is required for admission to Nursery. Medical examination and hygiene checks are compulsory.
- The Assessment evaluates the level of the child's skill in English & Math for a particular grade. Student counsellors will meet prospective students and their parents/guardians on the same day to identify children who need special attention.
- Assessment for admission to grades (Nursery to 5th) is conducted on all days including Sundays from 1st December onwards.
- Admission forms are available online on the website (akalacademybarusahib.com), and offline can be obtained from the admission cell of the school premises.
- The parents of eligible students are informed about the date and venue the of written test. If qualified, the parents are informed about the next course of admission within 48 hours i.e. the Documents required and the date of joining.
- If the candidate fulfils the above criteria, the admission fee and the first instalment of the fee are required to be deposited.

Documents Required

- Transfer certificate (school leaving) from the previous school in original.
- Academic record of the child from the previous school (Report card/Student's portfolio/Academic achievement)
- Authentic Date of Birth Certificate (Issued by Registrar, Births/Municipal committees) in Original.
- Photocopy of the Aadhar card of the child (mandatory).
- Passport-size photographs of the child (8 copies).
- Passport-size photographs of the parents (2 copies each) and all other persons (one copy) Authorized by parents to meet the child on visiting / meeting days (maximum 3 persons)
- Medical Fitness from a qualified child's specialist (pediatrician) with vaccination status (MMR, typhoid, chickenpox &hepatitis B, X-ray test of the chest, dental report, urine examination, eye check-up, haemoglobin, ENT, blood group. (Mandatory)
- Photocopy of the ID cards of the parents (Aadhar card, Passport, Driving license, Voter Id).
- Declaration by the parents to follow the Rules and Regulations mentioned in the Admission form.
- First Instalment of the annual dues i. e. Rs. 90,000/-for Indian students & Rs.1,90,000 for NRI students either by cash or D.D. in favor of Akal Academy, Baru Sahib payable at SBI, Gurdwara Baru Sahib Bank Code 11784.
- VISA and Passport (For NRI Students) are to be submitted at the time of admission.

FAQ's regarding New-Admission

When was IB school established?

IB Primary Years Programme school was established in 2013.

How one can reach Baru Sahib?

Baru Sahib can be reached by Solan, Rajgarh route. The approximate distance of Baru Sahib from Solan is about 60 to 65 Kms. The nearest Airport to Baru Sahib is Chandigarh.

What are the possible routes to reach?

- Delhi to Baru Sahib: 310 Km. (Via Nahan, Bagthan, Machher)
- Dehradun to Baru Sahib: 170 Km (Via Poanta Sahib, Nahan, Banethi)
- Chandigarh to Baru Sahib: 135 Km. (via Solan, Rajgarh, Kheri, Machher)
- From Solan to Rajgarh, the frequency of bus is 30 minutes.
- Rental cabs are available round the clock.

What are the grades up to which admissions can be sought?

We admit children between 3 to 12 years of age in different grades. Class Nursery is the entry-level for school admission.

How is the Primary Years Programme different from other elementary School programs?

The IB Primary Years Programme provides an educational framework based on what is currently known and how young children learn. It draws on the best practices in elementary school instruction.

The IB Primary Years Programme requires all teachers in the school to plan units of instruction and lessons collaboratively around six important themes. The collaboration facilitates a carefully thought-out and sequential development of skills, knowledge, and attitudes, while the organizing themes provide both students and teachers with a rich and inviting learning environment for exploration. In brief, the six organizing themes are: Who are we; Where are we in place and time; How do we express ourselves; How the world works; How do we organize ourselves; and How do we share the planet?

In the IB Primary Years Programme, students are taught to understand that learning is about asking questions and looking for answers, which in turn may generate new, and perhaps more complex questions in need of answers. As teachers work with students through this programme of guided inquiry, they also help students understand what their relationship and responsibility is towards what they are learning. In IB Primary Years Programme character-building shares a prominent place alongside learning.

FAQ's regarding New-Admission

Can Students transfer easily from one Primary Years Programme school to another?

Keeping in mind that each school determines its own admission and placement standards, the essential elements of the IB Primary Years Programme will be the same from school to school. However, since the IB does not prescribe the curriculum to be taught, that may vary from school to school.

Do Primary Years Programme students have to take IB examination?

There is no IB Examination in the Primary Years Programme. Student assessment is organized and conducted by the teachers in the school.

How can my child enroll in the Primary Years Programme?

Only the students who are enrolled in IB-authorized schools are permitted to participate in the Primary Years Programme.

Are all children in my school required to participate in the Primary Years Programme?

Yes. The Primary Years Programme is intended for all children ages 3-12 in the school, regardless of their learning needs.

Can students with special needs participate in the Primary Years Programme?

Yes. IB-authorized schools are expected to involve all of their students in the Primary Years Programme, regardless of their learning needs. The IB refers to this as a "whole school approach." The IB expects that schools will make any necessary accommodations for students with special needs.

How does the international board or curriculum ensure quality of teaching & learning?

- 1. All the teachers have to be trained by International Baccalaureate Master trainees as continuous professional development (CPD).
- 2. Evaluation visit by IB Asia Pacific inspectors & facilitators all over the globe to observe teaching over period 3 days.
- 3. Akal Academy Baru Sahib new campus International Baccalaureate has completed evaluation twice in the last 10 years.
- 4.Akal Academy Baru Sahib New Campus was the first School beyond NCR & was authorised to run PYP (3years to 12years) by IB (Geneva) in the year 2013.
